ALCOHOL & DRUG POLICY

The consumption of alcohol or use of illegal drugs is a serious personal responsibility involving the safety of family, riding friends, and the individual members of the American Legion Riders (ALR) Chapter members.

It is a fact that operating a motorcycle (or other motor vehicle) requires a great amount of mental alertness and physical skills. The operator may be presented with situations that require the timely assessment of the situation and the immediate execution of maneuvers requiring an extremely high level of skill and concentration.

It is recognized that the consumption of alcoholic beverages or the use of illegal drugs can interfere with the ability of the operator of a motorcycle (or other motor vehicle) to assess situations and execute maneuvers requiring high skill levels to the best of the operator's ability.

In consideration for the operator's safety, the safety of ALR Chapter members and guests involved in a Chapter sponsored ride, we have a ZERO Tolerance Policy toward the consumption or use of alcohol and or illegal drugs..

Alcohol or illegal drugs will not be consumed or used before or during ALR Chapter rides. A rider who has consumed alcohol or drugs or appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs – legal or illegal – will be asked to not participate in the Chapter ride. This includes over the counter drugs (OTC) which may affect the ability to ride safely.

If all efforts to separate the Chapter member or guest from the ride, whose conduct is in conflict with this policy, are unsuccessful, the Chapter ride will be terminated.

The Legion liability insurance does not cover individuals under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Legionaries' insurance does not cover individuals under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
